On January 21st, the Union's bargaining committee met to finalize our proposal package in preparation for upcoming negotiations with the City of Winnipeg. The union's proposals were developed based on the membership priorities identified in the bargaining survey. The next step of the process will be to exchange proposals with the City of Winnipeg.

Bargaining to commence in February
